This decision comes a few hours after the official announcement of the results of the presidential election by the Constitutional Council and four days before the transfer of powers scheduled on Sunday 14 May between outgoing President François Hollande and newly President-elect Emmanuel Macron. The names of the prime minister and members of the new government, all kept silent for the time being, will be unveiled in the wake.

Bernard Caseneuve, Prime Minister explained " There is no question of promising anything, it would be too much of disappointments ". However, the President-elect consults a lot, has ideas, wishes and doubts. He will decide everything, but he is also subject to the imperatives realistic of the moment, constrained by his commitments to renewal, to surpassing parties. And within a few weeks of the legislative elections, the objective of the constitution of a majority in the Assembly obliges, so it will be necessary to give pledges to those who hesitate to play a role at his side."
