Moreover, the French President Macron's practice of English, increasingly expressed in Shakespeare's language at international summits or conferences, also marked a turning point in the communication of the French head of state, as his predecessors until then, were still speaking only in French with translation ... The French tradition of imposing the French to non-French speakers was swept very quickly by the forty-year-old President Emmanuel Macron, whose open approach to the rest of the world is appreciated by other heads of state and others. "French arrogance" is also blurred by this gesture of adaptation and strong diplomatic flexibility.-----

This video was buzzing around the world, and it was the beginning of an offensive communication campaign launched by President Macron, who decided to prepare for this high-level summit, which would be the starting point of a methodology. work plan, involving all the signatories of the agreement, setting a road map and a follow-up, to compare actions to words and promises, and validate the urgent recommendations of the Paris agreement. This summit is therefore only the beginning of future successive operations of high-level meetings to both counter the US misunderstanding of the climate agreement and especially to protect the planet which already suffers too much from natural disasters, related to climate change.

Indeed, this place is faithful to its founding ambition, because it is the new popular and sophisticated destination of the live show of the west of Paris. It is "a permanent music festival for all ages" as said Jean-Luc Choplin, president of the programming committee of STS Event.-----

The venue is fully committed to this high-level summit, with a configuration of the auditorium, like the plenary room of the United Nations in New York, close to the modernity and special effects of light and digital screens, plasma and other avant-garde accessories, have added a modern touch and turned rather towards the future, and wanting to move forward. The subliminal message is clear, to emerge the 12 concrete announcements to apply now in line with the recommendations of the Parisian and the Paris Agreement of COP21, going further than this agreement "if conventional UN" and bring a dynamism at the "Macron" by acts quickly executed and followed. The message was heard and widely relayed by the high-level participants, who are heads of state, more than sixty countries and sovereigns, (King of Morocco, Mohammed VI, Prince ruler, Albert of Monaco, King of Arabia Saudi Arabia, Mohammed Ben Salman Al Saud) and other dignitaries as well as prestigious business leaders such as Michael Bloomberg, Richard Branson, Bill Gates, Arnold Schwarzenegger, John Kerry, Richard Attias, activists like Marion Cotillard, Sean Penn ... and others representatives of international institutions. They all agreed on the clear message and speaking with one voice "The planet is the priority of all and the Paris Agreement is non-negotiable despite the withdrawal of the US, following the announcement made by Donald Trump". Closing the summit, President Macron then announced the 12 Climat Acts, decided at this high-level meeting, the "One Planet Summit", as well as the roadmap and the announcement of the forthcoming launch of a global platform inviting anyone to "register to act, interact, propose innovative ideas to fight against climate change." Michael Bloomberg meanwhile, as well as Arnold Schwarzenegger explained that the governors, mayors of the cities and businessmen of the USA, do not need "the blessing of Trump" to align themselves by the common sense, and the interest also to seize new profitable new business opportunities, to apply the Paris Agreement. They do not despair anyway, including President Macron as Donald Trump, perceive finally this message so strong, common sense, intentional and benevolent towards the citizens of the world and the planet so that it changes its opinion in the coming months and keep the US, alongside China and India, also among the biggest polluters, already committed to the Paris agreement ... /
